Enhancements to the Pond Area

As we discussed at the past Neighborhood Annual Meeting, we are planning on adding a concrete pad and picnic table at the pond area. The pad will be on the Kings Church Road side of the pond about thirty foot off Kingswood Ave. The pad will be dug into the hillside to keep the front edge of the pad low to the ground with retaining walls to hold back the earth on three sides. We are planning on a metal table and later adding lighting to this area. We are just starting to get bids for this project so it may be late this year or early 2021 before it is completed. Annual HOA Dues

The invoices for our annual HOA dues are mailed each year on January 1st, with a due date of January 31st. We have many homeowners who are late in paying, which causes issues with budgeting and planning neighborhood improvements. Starting in 2021, we will be adding a \$5 late fee if not paid by the due date. We are directed in the by-laws to place a lien on any property with unpaid HOA dues, including 12% per year interest and filing fees added. The HOA will not receive the money until the property is sold, and we would rather homeowners make arrangements to pay so we do not hurt their credit rating.
